ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, among others, orders have been issued for revised sharing pattern of reimbursement getting accrued in the Government Hospitals under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme as detailed below:

Sharing pattern	In percentage
Incentive to Medical Team	15%
Hospitals upgradation/ Infrastructure	17%
Corpus fund	27%
Consumables	40%
IEC	01%
Total	100%

And also sanction a sum of Rs.25.00 crore to the Corpus Fund under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme as one time measure.

2. In Government Orders second and third read above, among others, orders have been issued to exempt from deduction of 28% Corpus Fund / IEC Fund from Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme claims for certain procedures.

- 3. In the letter read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme as per the new tender guidelines 1090 packages are in existence and are being implemented. Since the consumables cost for certain procedures are more than 40% of the consumable cost and also inclusive of 15% incentives and 17% hospital upgradation fund eligible out of the total package cost, it is proposed to exempt the following packages from the corpus fund:-
 - 1. Packages for Cochlear accessories
 - 2. Peritoneal dialysis and related sub packages
 - 3. Interventional radiology -29 packages
 - 4. Tissue plasminogen activator and recombinant tissue plasminogen activators

She has further requested the Government to provide exemption from deduction of corpus fund of 28% of the package cost (27% corpus fund + 1% IEC) as corpus fund for the above packages additionally under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme.

- 4. The Government after careful examination have decided to grant permission to exempt the deduction towards the consumable for the packages for Cochlear accessories, Peritoneal dialysis & related sub packages, Interventional radiology-29 packages and TPA (Tissue Plasminogen activator & RTPA (Recombinant tissue plasminogen activators) and exemption from deduction of Corpus Fund, as proposed by Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project. Also the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is directed that the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme accounts be audited every quarter.
