The meeting was held to short out various issues related to delay in pre-auth and claims in Govt.Hospital CMCHIS. The following were discussed and accepted on.

- 1.) Clinical photo not be insisted for Govt.Hospitals (UIIC).
- 2.) For all cases where there are asked and not in minimum requirements as staging of cancers, Hydatidcyst, Appendix Perforation, Gastrectomy, minimum criteria to be revisited(UIIC/TNHSP).
- 3.) The discharge summary and preauth ^{from} should contain the following details, nothing more to be insisted other than in brief the minimum requirements which would include date of admission, date of surgery/date of discharge, Procedure/diagnosis, Clinical features, Investigation, Treatment given, Post operative notes, Condition at discharge including medications (UIIC/ALL Govt Hospital).
- 4.) For Palliative chemotherapy beyond three cycles will be given subject to provision of proof of tumor response & patient compliance where consensus was eluding to be revisited (UIIC).
