

Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM)

Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) is a flagship scheme of the Government of India aimed at building an integrated digital health ecosystem in the country.

ABDM aims to build the digital health backbone of the country necessary to bring all stakeholders together in one common ecosystem.

Main Components of ABDM



Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA)

Unique health identifier for all individuals that enables access to digital health services and secure storage of health records.



Healthcare Professionals Registry (HPR)

Registry of verified public and private healthcare professionals serving across all systems of medicine.



Health Facility Registry (HFR)

Registry of verified public and private health facilities like hospitals, diagnostic labs, pharmacies, health centres etc.,



Personal Health Records App (PHR App)

ABDM-enabled applications like ABHA app, Aarogya Setu etc., that allow easy management of personal health records.



Unified Health Interface (UHI)

An interface that enables seamless interaction and exchange of health information between different user applications and health service providers.

Increase visibility and improve overall business



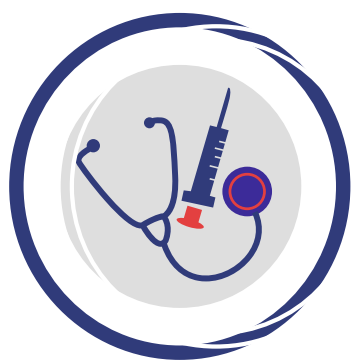
Easy Access

HPR Registration Process

- 1 | Scan the QR code or visit nhpr.abdm.gov.in/home to apply for HP ID using Aadhaar or Driving License
- 2 | Fill the registration form using personal, registration and work-related details

- Medical council registration details

- Current work-related details - appointment letter, recent pay slip, transfer order

Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA)

Create ABHA Go Digital



ABHA is a 14-digital unique health identifier that enables the individual to link, access and share their health records digitally.

How to get ABHA number?

- 1 Click on 'Create ABHA number'
- 2 Generate ABHA using Aadhaar
- 3 Authenticate Aadhaar and Mobile Number
- 4 Create/ Select an easy to remember username called ABHA Address
- 5 Click on 'Submit' to generate and download your ABHA number

*If your mobile number is not linked with Aadhaar, visit nearest ABDM registered health facility to create your ABHA by biometric authentication instead of OTP.

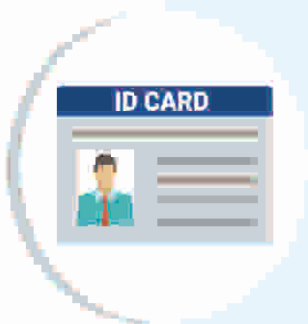
FACTS



ABHA is only for the socio-economically backward population of the country.



Health ID and ABHA number are two different IDs. I need to have both of them.



If I create ABHA, my data will be publicly available.



ABHA can be used only in government facilities.



ABHA makes me eligible for PMJAY benefits.



ABHA can be created only by visiting government facilities.



Any individual in India can create ABHA.

Health ID and ABHA are the same. Health ID has been renamed to Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA).

Your data will not be publicly available if you create ABHA. You can share your health records with healthcare professionals and facilities using ABHA only after your explicit consent.

You can use your ABHA as a Health ID and to link your health records digitally at any ABDM registered health facility across public or private sector.

ABHA is Ayushman Bharat Health Account that helps you get digital health services. This is not the same as the Ayushman Card given to only eligible beneficiaries of the AB-PMJAY scheme. ABHA doesn't promise any financial benefits.

You can create ABHA online from the ABDM website or any ABDM-integrated app or by visiting any ABDM-registered health facilities nearby.
